Horses may be entered in a **maximum** of 3 classes per show.

Classes do not have to & probably will not run in order listed.

Classes may be joined or split at the discretion of the management.

* Novice Horse or Rider not to have earned 3 scores of 55% or higher at this level.

**Fabulous 50's - horse & rider pairs with combined age of 50+. Amateur Riders, No Professionals.

13 & Under classes, riders 13& under as of 1/1/2017.

Test of Choice classes may be entered multiple times for different tests. I.E. 2nd level test 1; 2nd level test 2.

DHD&CT Series Awards given for each class. Must show 2 of the 4 shows; same class, horse & rider combination, earning scores above 55%. For Test of Choice classes ridden more than once each show, the highest test score from each show will be used.

2017 Series Award Requirements: To qualify for series end awards, a minimum of 4 Volunteer Hours to directly benefit DHD&CT are required of members or non-members. A Volunteer sign-up sheet will be available at each event and the Volunteer is responsible for logging in their hours worked.
