Welcome to the 2018 Dancing Horse Dressage Schooling Show Series! This information packet includes show information, class information, year-end award information, and a standard entry form to be used for all Dancing Horse Dressage shows. We encourage everyone to participate as a competitor, volunteer and/or spectator.

ENTRIES: Entries MUST be mailed, i.e. no hand delivered entries will be accepted. Entries must be postmarked on or between the opening and closing dates of the show being entered to be valid. Complete entries must include:

- Fully executed entry form including ALL required signatures.
- Check for Entry Total
- Separate Stall Deposit Check for \$30.00 (if Applicable)
- Copy of current negative Coggins (blood drawn on date within past 12 months of show date)

The 2018 show series will be ONE RING only shows. ONLY COMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR SCHEDULING and entries will be prioritized based on the postmark date of the entry. Complete entries which cannot be scheduled due to the capacity limits of the show, will be prioritized (based on postmark date) and placed on a waiting list.

Horses may be entered in a MAXIMUM of 3 classes per show.

NSF CHECKS are subject to a \$40 recovery fee added to the check amount, plus all Dancing Horse Dressage bank fees. **COMPETITORS OWING REVENUES** to Dancing Horse Dressage (including stall deposit fees and any other outstanding monies) will be barred from further showing until such debts are paid in full.

REFUNDS: Scratches before closing date are given a full refund (entries and stalls/grounds fees). Once the closing date has been reached, all fees associated with complete entries are nonrefundable with the exception of the “stall cleaning deposit”, which will be refunded in the event of a scratch after the closing date. “Stall fees” related to scratches may be refunded by submitting a written request to the Show Secretary. Refund Exception: If a valid, complete entry cannot be scheduled due to the capacity limits of the show, the entry is 100% refundable.

CANCELLATIONS: In case of impending severe weather such as a hurricane, a committee consisting of the President and Show Manager may cancel a show. Any cancellation due to weather will be posted on

www.dancinghorsesdressage.org by noon the day preceding the show. The show may be rescheduled at a later date, not necessarily at the same venue. Competitors will be credited for all fees in the event of cancellation for inclement weather.

WEATHER DELAYS: In the case of severe weather such as rain, thunder, lightning or hail, the Show Manager on site may call for a delay of the show without consulting other committee members. When the show is resumed, it will continue in the order of go as listed in the program. IF A COMPETITOR HAS LEFT THE SHOWGROUND, IT WILL BE CONSIDERED A SCRATCH AND NO REFUND OF ANY KIND WILL BE MADE. If the show cannot be resumed due to unsafe weather conditions, the show committee will determine if the remaining classes can be rescheduled at a later date or if the cancellation will stand. Competitors will be credited for all fees in the event of cancellation for inclement weather.

RIDE TIMES: Posted on the Dancing Horse Dressage Website, <http://dancinghorsesdressage.org/>, after noon on Wednesday prior to the show.

TACK AND ATTIRE: The Dancing Horse Dressage Schooling Shows will follow the USEF, USDF, FEI, or WDAA rules as appropriate, with an exception to DR120 Dress Code. Each competitor is responsible for knowing the rules; <http://dancinghorsesdressage.org/show-rules/>

DR120 Dress Code Exception: Riding Coats are optional for all test levels. If no coat is worn, shirts must have sleeves (long or short) and a collar, without neckwear.

CLASS PLACING AWARDS: First place award and ribbons for first through sixth place. If not picked up at the show, unclaimed class ribbons/awards will be returned to club inventory.

SHOW HIGH SCORE AWARDS: DHD & CT High Score Awards will be given at each show for Intro, Training Level, 1st Level, 2nd Level & Above and Western Dressage. A minimum of 3 riders at the level are required for these awards to be given. All shows are Jockey Club TIP approved and the High score TIP registered horse and rider combination at Intro, Training Level, 1st Level, 2nd Level & Above and Western Dressage will also be awarded.

CHECK SCORES BEFORE LEAVING SHOW GROUNDS. Corrections gladly made in show office on show day. No corrections will be made after the end of the show.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED! Dancing Horse Dressage is a volunteer organization and depends on club members to help support its activities. Volunteers are rewarded with vouchers that can be used towards year end awards, educational rewards, and other club designated opportunities. YEAR-END SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

DHD & CT Champion and Reserve Champion Series Awards will be given for each class. The parameters for this recognition are:

- Rider and owner of horse do NOT have to be members of DHD & CT.
- To be eligible, rider must redeem Volunteer Hours Vouchers which equate to 4 volunteer service hours; volunteer service must benefit DHD & CT.
- At least two scores over 55% in the class, earned at 2 shows for the same horse/rider combination are required for eligibility.
- In a TOC class entered multiple times by the same horse/rider combination, only the highest score, regardless of test, for the horse/rider combination for each individual show will be considered for the series awards.
- The two highest scores from the show series will be averaged to determine the Champion and Reserve champion for each class.

In addition, an award will be given to the overall high score TIP registered horse/rider combination.
